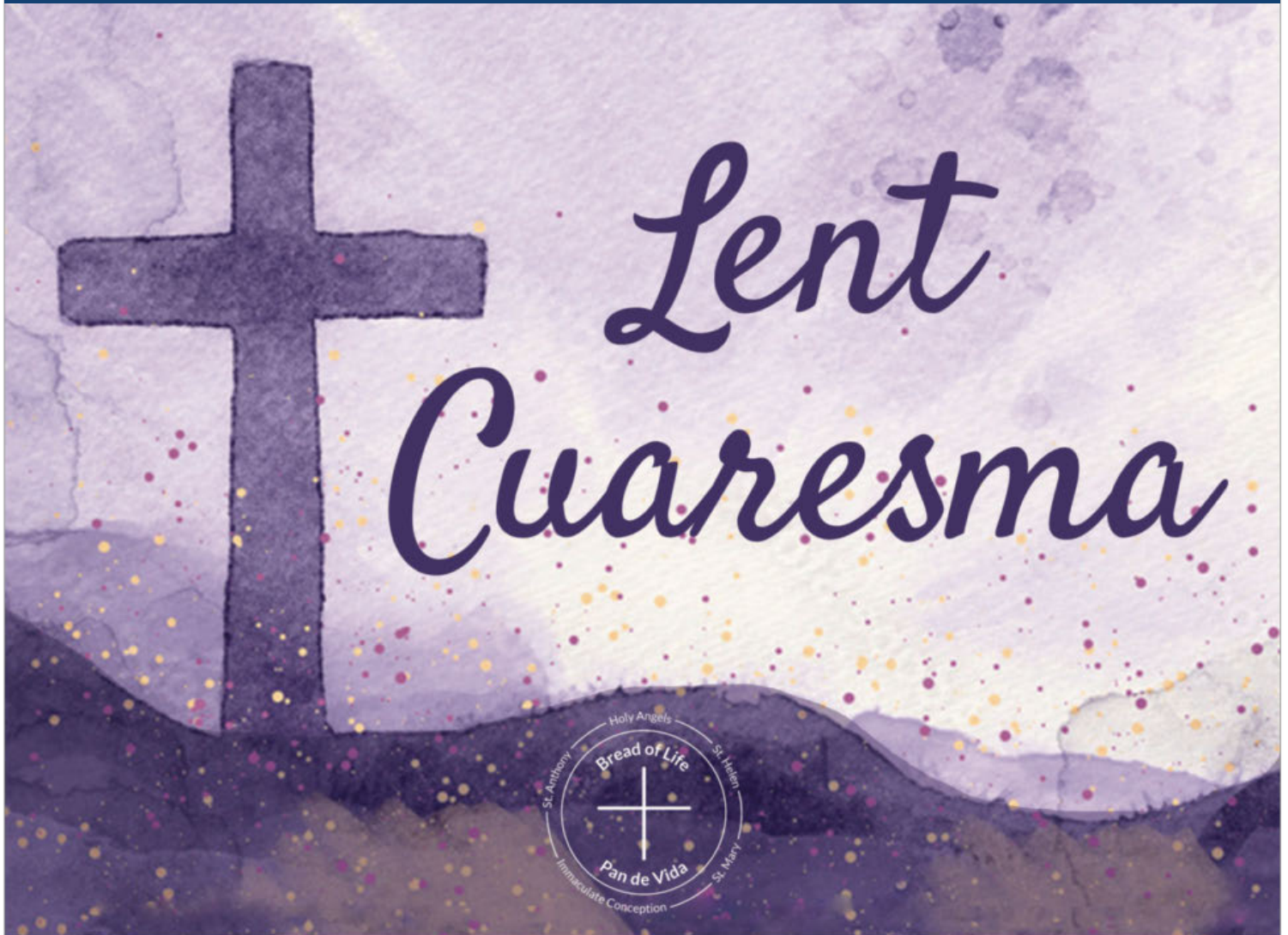

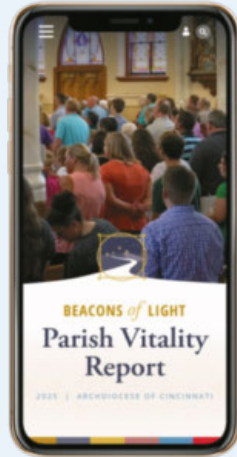

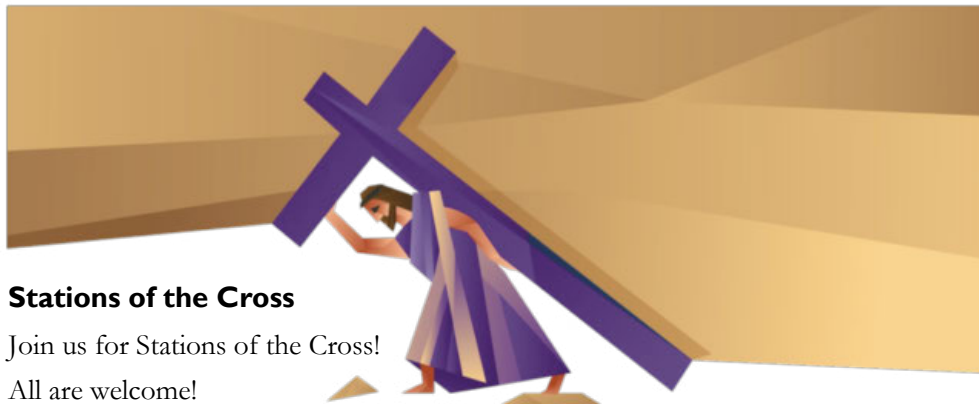

Lenten Almsgiving Projects

St. Helen: Stork's Nest Baby Pantry

A new Dayton Right to Life satellite location with Stork's Nest Baby Pantry will be opening at 4130 Linden Ave. Ste. 340, Dayton 45432 on April 12. The pantry will serve parents and guardians of children newborn to age 5 who need help providing basic needs for their children.



In order to support their clients, the following items are needed:

- Diapers (all sizes), wipes and formula (all kinds)
- Pull Ups (all sizes)
- Clothing size Newborn to 5T
- Toddler socks and shoes (all sizes)
- Infant bath towels and accessories (baby wash, shampoo, lotion)
- Bottles, burp cloths, and crib sheets
- Receiving blankets
- Pacifiers
- Baby foods-cereal, toddler snacks, and jarred fruits & vegetables-all stages

There will be baskets in St. Helen's vestibule for donation items. Checks are accepted and should be made payable to Dayton Right to Life, memo line: Linden Av. Location.

Immaculate Conception: Refugee & Immigrant Resettlement Assistance

Immaculate Conception's 2025 Lenten Almsgiving Project will build upon the work of last year. Our assistance helps immigrants and refugees settle into their new community by providing the necessities they need to establish a functioning household for their family. Monetary donations are best for this project because needs can vary greatly from family to family. Items can be purchased as a need arises. We will continue our practice of prioritizing those who are ineligible for other forms of assistance, such as families who enter through the "immigration lottery" and thus are ineligible for refugee resettlement assistance from Catholic Social Services of the Miami Valley.



You may contribute to the Almsgiving Project in multiple ways:

- In the collection by **check** (made out to the parish) either placed in an almsgiving envelope or with "almsgiving" written on the memo line.
- In the collection by **cash** placed in an almsgiving envelope or another envelope with "almsgiving" clearly labeled on it.

You are invited to bring non-perishable food items to the church until March 18. We will bless all the donations during the evening prayer scheduled in his honor on March 18 at 7:00 pm. Your donations will benefit the St. Vincent De Paul Food Pantry and the "Feed the Spirit" ministry to assist children in need that attend our school.

Please place your donation by the statue of St. Joseph in the Holy Family Chapel. If you bring them during the week and the church is not open, please take it to the church office.

While we will accept and be thankful for all food donations, we are targeting this year's collection to some of the most needed items in the food pantry. These items are as follows:

- Soups of all types
- Canned spaghetti & meatballs
- Canned Ravioli
- Canned Chili/Beef stew
- Breakfast cereal
- Canned meats (tuna, chicken breast etc.)
- Jelly
- Canned fruit
- Spaghetti sauce

The 'Feed the Spirit' ministry is in need of the below items.

- 2 items in greatest need are juice boxes/pouches and fruit cups
- Breakfast foods in individual bags or containers (oatmeal, cream of wheat, breakfast bars, pop tarts, cereal cups)
- Individual packs of snacks (raisins, crackers, pretzels, goldfish)
- Fruit or Vegetable individual cans (pop top) or cups (easy open) or applesauce
- Shelf stable white milk in single serve (small) cartons
- Easy open individual meals (must have pop top if a can) i.e. pasta meals in cups, mac-n-cheese in cups, cup-o-soup, any soup can with pop top, and ramen in cups

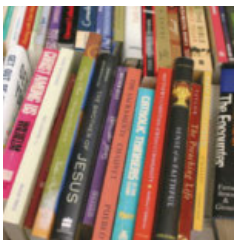


The next turn in will be **Monday, April 7, in the Smith Building between 6:30-8:00 pm**.

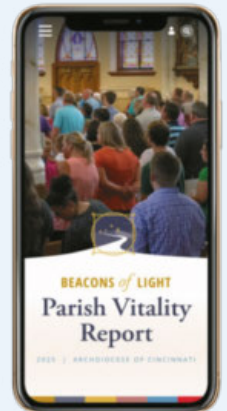

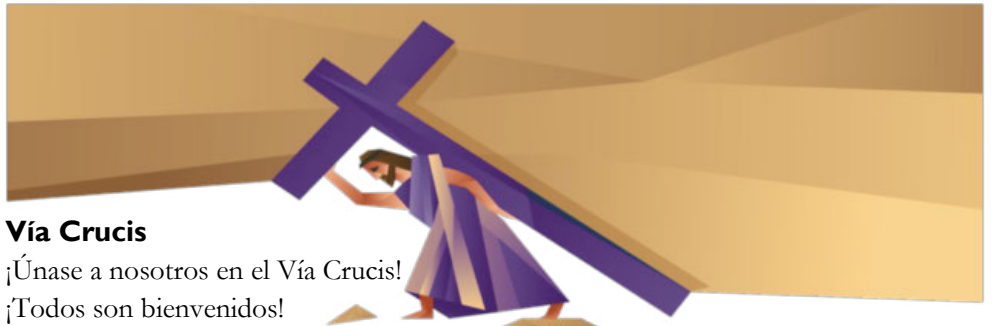
