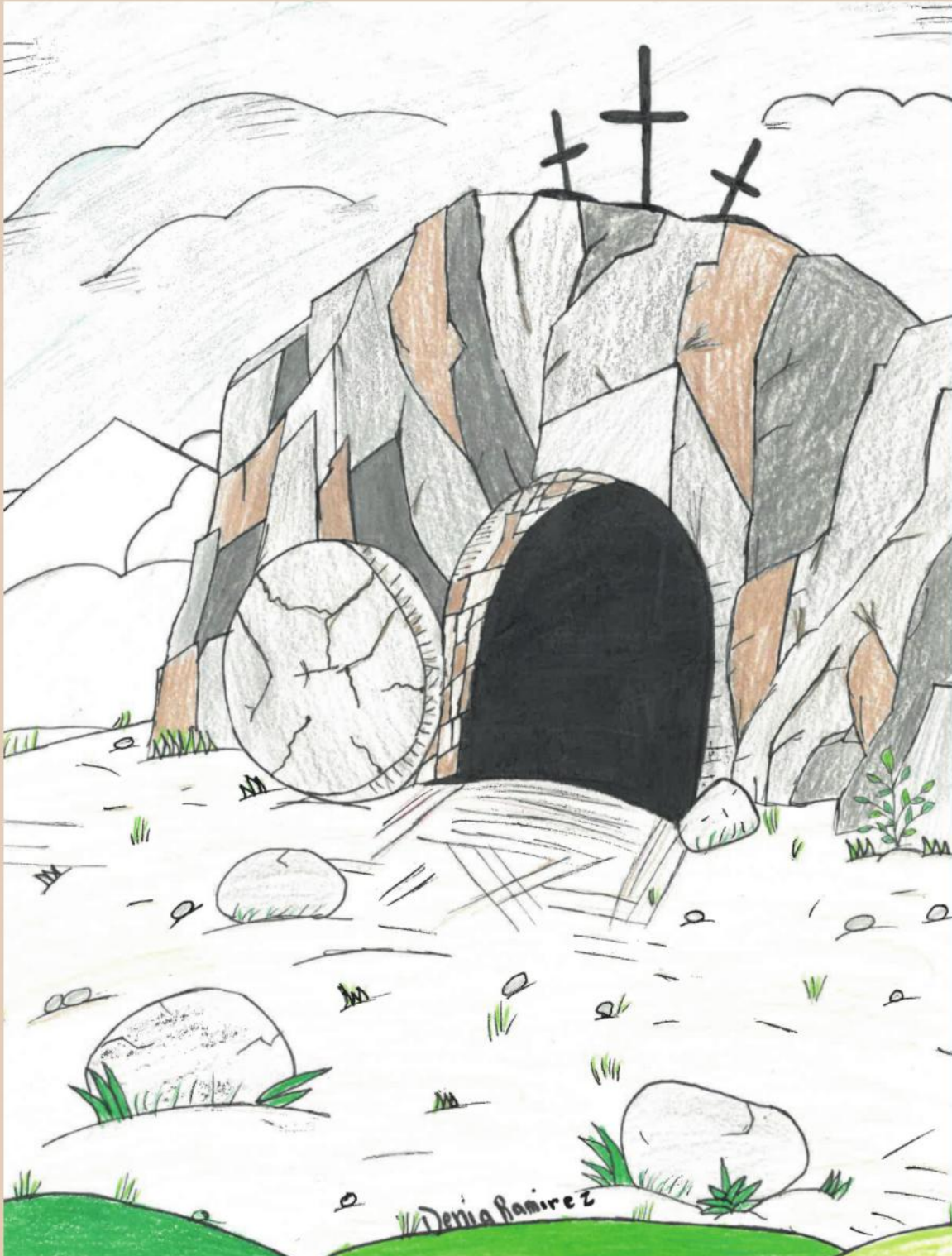

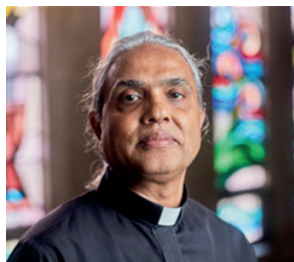

MESSAGE FROM FR. SATISH

Easter Serenity



It has been, what I have felt, a long Lent. Because Easter is the latest it might be in a given year, Lent felt dragged out. I don't mean anything negative when I say this. The gradual pace slowed Lent down for me. Everything became more intentional, purposeful, and meaningful. Now, there is a sense of serenity as I embrace the promise of Easter.

Surprisingly, this serenity comes at a time when there is great turmoil. As I write this letter, the stock market is in turmoil. World trade is in turmoil. The lives and the families of the vulnerable immigrant community is in turmoil. Federal workers have had their lives upended. Wars that could have ended are still raging and new ones are threatening to surface. The serenity I feel within betrays the unsettling feeling without. Perhaps it is because the long but slow Lent gave me the time to pause, to pray, to look deeper. In so many ways, my sentiment is precisely the spirit of Easter – serenity that comes from a resurrected Christ who overcame a world embroiled in sin and darkness. The turmoil is real and so is the power of the love.

After all, that first Easter was not all pretty. As the stone was rolled away, bloodstains still tainted the Calvary hill. As new life dawned, three crosses still marked the horizon. The disciples were in turmoil. Some hid themselves for fear, others were plagued by doubt, as still others waited for any news with bated breath. But that first Easter dawn was the most serene of all dawns since the first day of creation. As gentle as the kiss of first sunlight upon the dark earth, new life serenely set upon the dark world. A promise had been kept. A Covenant had been sealed. Death had been overcome. New life had sprung. Jesus had risen from the dead. Turmoil surrendered to the power of love.

Is this the serenity that I sense within me this Easter? I pray it is. And I pray it for every one of you too!

Yet, as I look deeper, I find another reason. Lent and Holy Week 2025 also gave me great fulfillment as a family of parishes. Not only did the Bread of Life Family of Parishes come together for many Lenten activities, but for the first time we celebrated the entire Triduum together, much of it bilingually. On Holy Thursday, people who have never seen and known each other, or spoken each other's language, washed each other's feet. We gathered under the shadow of the same cross on Good Friday. Our common Easter Vigil captured the very victory Jesus had won over sin, turmoil, and darkness. The priests, liturgical ministers, the English and Spanish choirs, the staff, and the people worshipping with one heart and one voice is indeed the beginning of a new era. The turmoil of the last few years has seen a glimpse of Easter possibilities. The vision I have constantly held aloft at meetings and gatherings of our community coming together for the sake of mission holds true promise. My heartfelt gratitude to every one of you!

I have a deeper understanding of the serenity, then, to which I made a reference at the beginning. More than a personal experience, my serenity is founded on the witness of the Bread of Life Family of Parishes. I believe that our experience will help us, like the first disciples, to take the good news to the world outside. May our witness that turmoil, doubt, fear, and insecurity are not the last words, bring hope and serenity to our world.

Happy Easter!

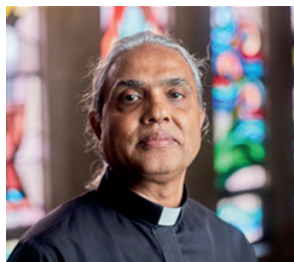

MENSAJE DEL PADRE SATISH

La Serenidad de la Pascua



Ha sido, según he sentido, una Cuaresma larga. Como la Pascua es la más tardía del año, la Cuaresma se alargó. No pretendo nada negativo. El ritmo gradual hizo que la Cuaresma fuera más lenta para mí. Todo se volvió más intencional, con más propósito y significado. Ahora, siento una sensación de serenidad al acoger la promesa de la Pascua.

Sorprendentemente, esta serenidad llega en un momento de gran agitación. Mientras escribo esta carta, el mercado de valores está en crisis. El comercio mundial está en crisis. Las vidas y las familias de la vulnerable comunidad inmigrante están en crisis. Los trabajadores federales

han visto sus vidas trastocadas. Guerras que podrían haber terminado aún continúan y otras nuevas amenazan con surgir. La serenidad que siento por dentro delata la inquietud que siento por fuera. Quizás se deba a que la larga pero lenta Cuaresma me dio tiempo para detenerme, orar y profundizar. En muchos sentidos, mi sentimiento refleja precisamente el espíritu de la Pascua: la serenidad que proviene de un Cristo resucitado que venció a un mundo sumido en el pecado y la oscuridad. La agitación es real, y también lo es el poder del amor.

Después de todo, aquella primera Pascua no fue del todo bonita. Mientras la piedra era removida, aún había manchas de sangre en el Calvario. Al amanecer de una nueva vida, tres cruces aún marcaban el horizonte. Los discípulos estaban turbados. Algunos se escondieron por miedo, otros estaban acosados por la duda, y otros esperaban con ansias cualquier noticia. Pero aquel primer amanecer de Pascua fue el más sereno de todos desde el primer día de la creación. Tan suave como el beso de la primera luz del sol sobre la tierra oscura, una nueva vida se posó serenamente en el mundo oscuro. Una promesa se había cumplido. Un pacto se había sellado. La muerte había sido vencida. Una nueva vida había brotado. Jesús había resucitado de entre los muertos. La turbación se rindió al poder del amor.

¿Es esta la serenidad que siento en mi interior esta Pascua? Ruego que así sea. ¡Y ruego por cada uno de ustedes también!

Sin embargo, al profundizar, encuentro otra razón. La Cuaresma y la Semana Santa de 2025 también me brindaron una gran plenitud como familia de parroquias. La Familia de Parroquias Pan de Vida no solo se reunió para muchas actividades cuaresmales, sino que por primera vez celebramos juntos todo el Triduo, gran parte de forma bilingüe. El Jueves Santo, personas que nunca se habían visto ni conocido, ni hablado el mismo idioma, se lavaron los pies. Nos reunimos bajo la sombra de la misma cruz el Viernes Santo. Nuestra Vigilia Pascual común capturó la misma victoria que Jesús obtuvo sobre el pecado, la confusión y la oscuridad. Los sacerdotes, los ministros litúrgicos, los coros en inglés y español, el personal y la gente, adorando con un solo corazón y una sola voz, representan sin duda el comienzo de una nueva era. La agitación de los últimos años ha vislumbrado las posibilidades de la Pascua. La visión que siempre he mantenido en alto en las reuniones de nuestra comunidad, unida por el bien de la misión, es muy prometedora. ¡Mi más sincera gratitud a cada uno de ustedes!

Comprendo entonces con mayor profundidad la serenidad a la que me referí al principio. Más que una experiencia personal, mi serenidad se basa en el testimonio de la Familia de Parroquias Pan de Vida. Creo que nuestra experiencia nos ayudará, como a los primeros discípulos, a llevar la buena nueva al mundo exterior. Que nuestro testimonio de que la confusión, la duda, el miedo y la inseguridad no son la última palabra, traiga esperanza y serenidad a nuestro mundo.

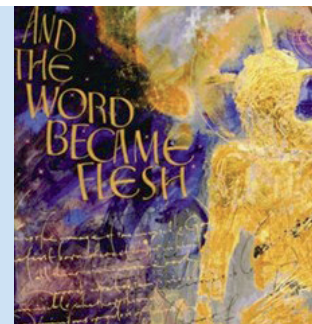

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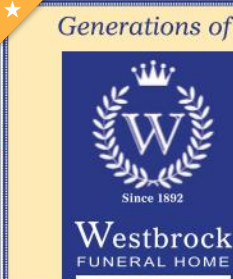
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
